CAMP R.I.C. BARRACKS. 19-2-1920.

The attack on this barracks was carried out by the 4th and 1st. Tralee Battalions on 19th February, 1920.

The plan of attack was, briefly, to blow a hole in the gable of the barracks with gelignite while covering parties kept the garrison busy. A party was kept ready to rush the barracks and capture the men garrisoning it, when the barracks was to be destroyed.

The attackers accordingly went into action with rifles, revolvers and shotguns while an attempt was made to blow a hole in the gable as planned. The bomb was placed in gable at back of kitchen range and failed to make a hole larger than a foot square and the I.R.A. forces had to be then withdrawn. An R.I.C. Sergeant in Charge was slightly wounded in face. The police replied to the I.R.A. attack with rifles and grenades.

Approximately 40 men from 4th Battl area took part in the actual attack and about 100 others helped in scouting, transport, blocking of roads, etc.

The police in the Barracks consisted of two Sergeants and about 12 men.

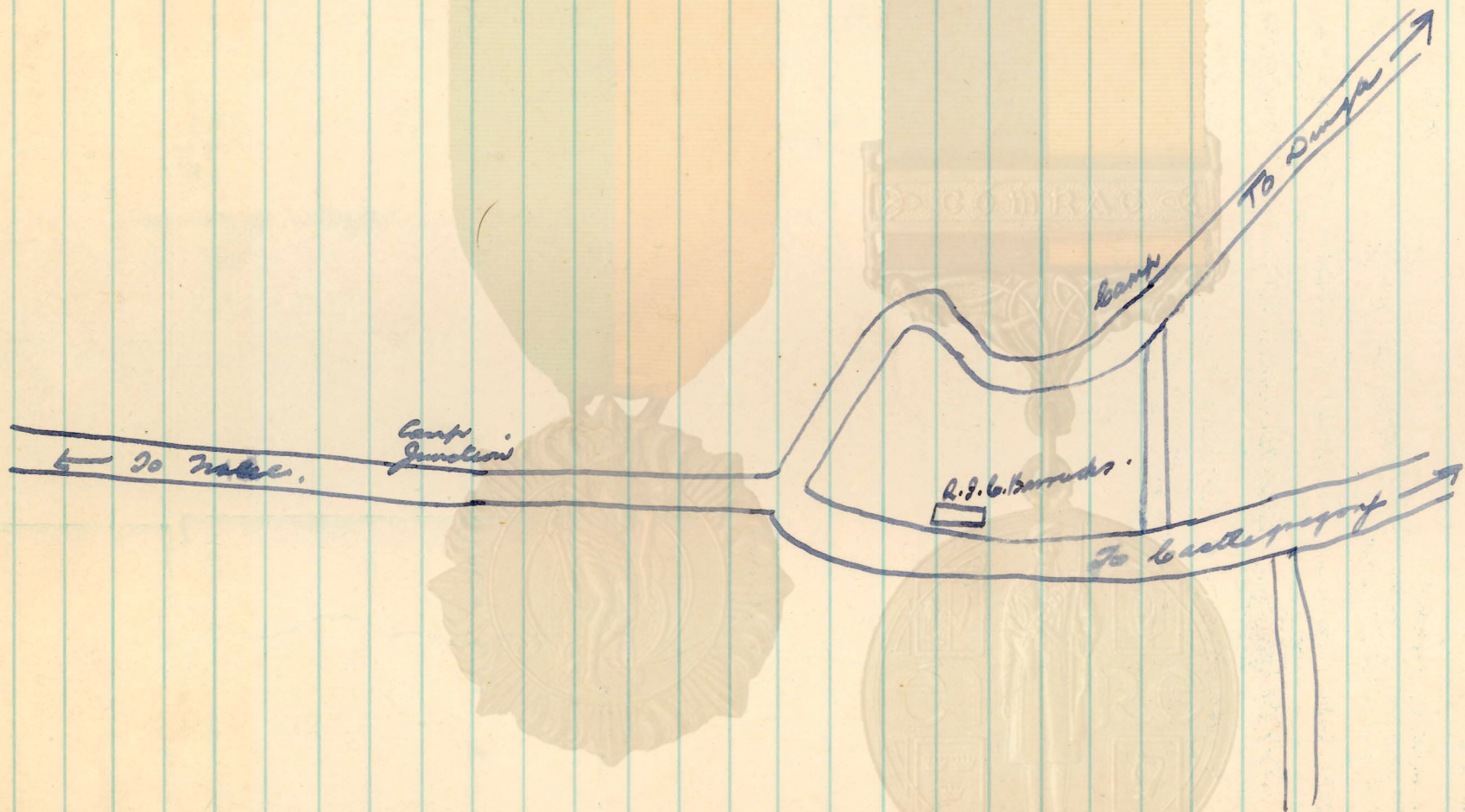

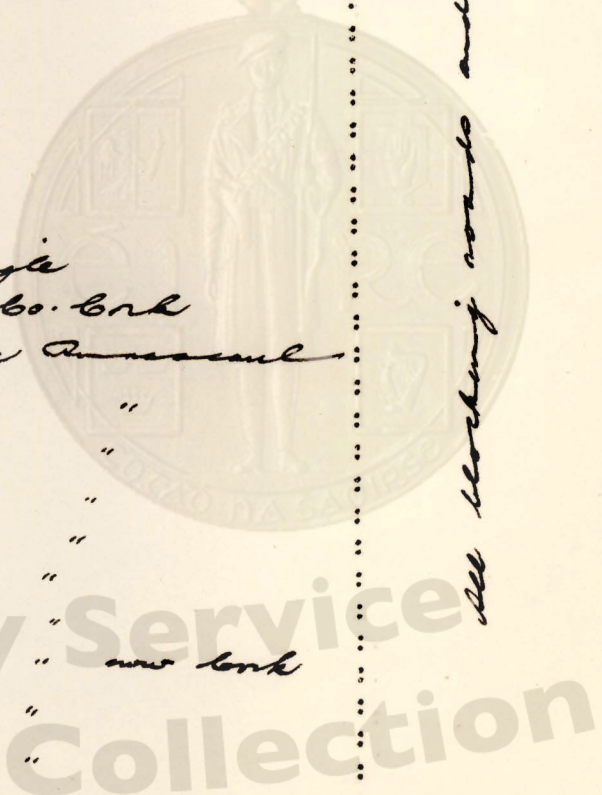
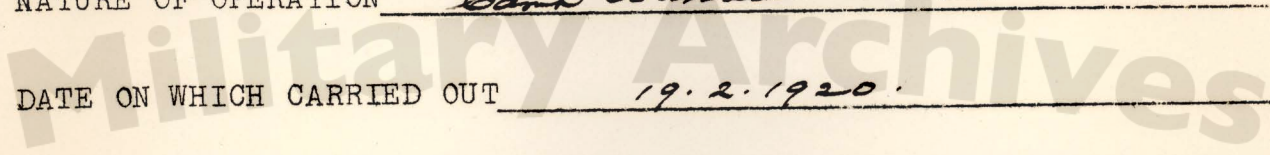
