It was decided to attack and capture Ardmore R.I.C. Bks., and plans were made accordingly.

A mine was to be laid against one of the gables and exploded. There was a narrow space between the Barrack gable and the adjoining house. Armed parties were placed in good positions in front and rear of Barracks, covering windows and doors. The party with mine crawled into position with mine and were proceeding to place it when some bricks in the wall over their heads were removed and rifle muzzles pushed out, covering the party who had to withdraw. Their withdrawal being covered by concentrated fire on windows and doors by the parties placed in positions in front and rear. It was found impossible to place the mine in another position owing to dropping of grenades by the Garrison, who kept up a heavy fire on our positions. The attack continued from all our positions, in windows, doors, and roof and lasted about four hours. Eventually our party had to withdraw as the fire of the garrison was in several cases hitting houses near the Barrack and endangering the residents.

A party was posted surrounding the Coast Guard Station. This party opened fire on the Station, and kept up a continuous fire, while the attack on the Barracks lasted. Rifle fire was returned. Road-blocking parties, posted at Youghal armed to attack any reinforcements from Youghal.

Ardmore party posted at Kiely's Cross, R.I.C.-Bks, with instructions to attack if any movements were observed.

Armed party posted on the main road leading from Dungarvan to Old Parish, (same road connects up with Ardmore road) blocked roads and in position to attack any reinforcements coming that way.
