The attacking party entered the village Rifle and shot-gun men were placed in their allotted positions, the party with bombs, petrol, and sprayer took possession of house next to Barrack. When all were in position, The rifle and shot-gun men opened the attack, the R.I.C. men replied from the Barrack with rifle fire and bombs and sent up vary lights. Scouts observed Military approaching in Lorrys from Waterford City, we then decided to retreat.
