

ATTACK ON KILL R.I.C. BARRACKS. Sept. 1920. (5th. Battn.)

Our party mobilised at Battn. H.Q. and there received rifles, revolvers, and shot-guns, bombs, petrol, and spraying machine, and proceeded towards Kill village. When near the village we halted, a small party made a surprise entry into the village as we had information that we may capture some of the R.I.C. men away from Barrack, in this they captured one R.I.C. man. The attacking party entered the village Rifle and shot-gun men were placed in their allotted positions, the party with bombs, petrol, and sprayer took possession of house next to Barrack. When all were in position, The rifle and shot-gun men opened the attack, the R.I.C. men replied from the Barrack with rifle fire and bombs and sent up vary lights. Scouts observed Military approaching in Lorrys from Waterford City, we then decided to retreat. No casualties.
