After the attack on Ardmore R.I.C. Barracks in Jan. 1920, a strong force of Marines were drafted into the village, taking up their position in Coast Guard Station, which is a large fortified building overlooking the district. A further attempt to take the barracks in the following August also failed. On this occasion, the Marines, though expected to do so, did not come to help the R.I.C. garrison, but a party of enemy soldiers did come from Youghal. As a result of these experiences, the operations of Nov. 1, at Ardmore and Kinsalebeg, were planned. The latter place is better known locally as PILTOWN.

On the night of Nov. 1, it was decided to carry out simultaneous attacks on Ardmore Barracks and Marine Station. The local Coy., and some A.S.U. men were to be responsible for this part of the operations, with instructions to have the attacks as prolonged as possible. The other Companies in the Battn. were detailed for other necessary duties, and men were picked from each unit to reinforce the A.S.U., which had moved into the area after the Pike Ambush. Companies from other Battalions were also mobilized for road-blocking, cutting wires and holding up any help that might come from Dungarvan. Sections from local Units were on Scout duty on different roads leading to Piltown, and they also provided an armed party on duty at Ferry Point to cope with the possibility of a landing there by boat of enemy forces from Youghal.

The main body of A.S.U. and picked men from the Brigade, took up their positions at Piltown Cross at 8.30 p.m. This Cross Roads is about two miles from Youghal, three from Ardmore, on the main Dungarvan-Youghal road. The attacks were then started at Ardmore by the throwing of Mills bombs at door of barrack by three men of A.S.U. who then returned to their positions at Piltown, leaving the local men to carry on the attacks on the Marine Station and R.I.C. barracks. The enemy in both places replied with rifle and machine gun fire. Verrey and Parachute lights were sent up by the garrisons.

About 11.0. p.m., the scouts between Piltown and Youghal reported activity in Youghal Barracks; lights were showing up and the sound of lorries and cars starting was heard. Some time later enemy transport was reported moving through the town and about 11.45 p.m. the message came that they were coming. The enemy ran right into the ambush position, coming to stop where a trench had been dug and a tree thrown across the road. The order to fire was promptly obeyed, the first shots accounting for the driver who was fatally wounded. Fire then became general, and a lull in enemy reply, the Volunteers jumped from their positions and charged the enemy, who began to put up their hands and surrender, with the result that the party were captured and disarmed.

After the first shots, some of the enemy ran and got away in the darkness. The number captured was thirty, two were killed and six wounded. We had no casualties. We secured all the equipment and arms of the enemy and left them to get back to their barrack as best they could, after procuring a dray for them to carry their wounded.
