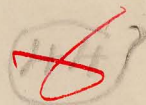

REMARKS. A dance was been held to raise funds to purchase rifles, when at 1 am. a sentry raised the alarm with a shot. The volunteers although practically unarmed attempted to fight their way to freedom but after a short exchange of shots ^{were} forced to surrender. Five I.R.A. were shot dead & one wounded. The rest were badly beaten ^{up} and were later taken to Limerick as prisoners.
